Medication Info for Year 6 Children on the residential trip in June 2023

Dear Parents/carers, for those children on the residential trip this year, please can I ask that medication is in school by Friday 10th June. Please note that parents are required to complete a medical consent form for any additional medication.

Children with Asthma pumps already in school, do not need to provide anything else, however if your child takes their brown pump, this must be in school, before Friday 10th June at the latest.

Important: All medication must go to Meena, our Welfare Assistant, no later than one week before the trip or by Friday 10th June. Consent forms will need completing for any additional medication that is taken including the brown Asthma pumps. **Please also note certain medication can only be accepted if it has been prescribed by the GP so it is important that you speak to Meena as soon as possible.**

If you have questions regarding medication please contact Meena who is happy and will assist with any worries or concerns.
